O P I N I O N

Del Mar Turf Club, a corporation, requests authority to discontinue service as a passenger stage corporation between the Palomar Airport in Carlsbad and the Del Mar Fairgrounds in Del Mar.

Said service is provided on racing days only and is primarily conducted for the purpose of transporting patrons, who arrive by chartered plane, from the airport to the track. According to applicant these individuals apparently prefer to use either limousine or taxi service. It is alleged that during the racing season from July 24, 1963 through September 11, 1963, applicant's operation resulted in an operating loss in the amount of \$1,800.

After consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require a continuation of applicant's service. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. On August 1, 1964 and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, Del Mar Turf Club may discontinue passenger stage service between the Palomar Airport in Carlsbad and the Del Mar Fairgrounds in Del Mar.

2. All tariffs and timetables presently on file with this Commission in applicant's name are canceled.

3. The operative rights created by Decision No. 60441, dated July 26, 1960, in Application No. 42414, are revoked.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
