O P I N I O N

A public hearing was held at San Francisco before Examiner Porter on March 14 and 15, 1961, and the matter was submitted subject to the filing of briefs. The briefs have been received and the matter is now ready for decision.

This investigation related primarily to the accumulation or combination of separate lots of produce into larger lots for rating purposes in a manner not permissible under tariff provisions then applicable. These tariff provisions were subsequently revised "in order to meet the practicalities attendant upon the harvesting, transportation and marketing of fresh fruit and vegetables."

(Decision No. 66586 dated January 7, 1964, in Case No. 5438, Petition for Modification No. 30 and Order Setting Hearing dated October 9, 1962.)

Upon consideration of the particular circumstances here present, the Commission finds that this investigation should be discontinued.
