ORDER

City of Sacramento is hereby authorized to widen the crossing of Florin Road at grade with a track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company, Crossing No. 4-132.9, in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, as described and substantially as shown in the application. Width of crossing shall be not less than seventy feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented by flashing light signals on cantilever arms.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Western Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant desires to begin construction as soon as possible and has requested immediate authorization.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
