OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant requests authority to carry out a contract with Del Monte Properties Company, dated January 27, 1964 (Application, Exhibit 1), for installation of water system facilities from time to time, under a master plan, in the Pebble Beach area of the utility's Monterey Peninsula Division. Applicant alleges that many of the extensions to be made by Del Monte in the area will be small, and that an extended series of individual contracts would result in unnecessary cost and expense to both applicant and Del Monte. Del Monte has joined in the request.

The contract provides for installations by Del Monte subject to prior approval by the utility of the size, location and design of the extension, or, if Del Monte should so request, the utility will install the facilities on advance of estimated costs therefor by Del Monte. The contract contains appropriate terms for payment or refund of the costs of the various extensions under either method of installation and is made subject to such changes or modifications as the Commission may direct in the exercise of its jurisdiction.

We find that execution of the subject contract will not be adverse to the public interest.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that applicant, after the effective date hereof, may carry out the terms and conditions of the contract referred to herein, and, within thirty days after execution of said contract, shall file with the Commission two fully conformed copies thereof, as executed. A public hearing is not necessary.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
