ORDER GRANTING INTERIM RELIEF

BONNIE R. BROWN of 1149% West 87th Street, Los Angeles, Califormia, having filed a verified complaint alleging in substance; that onor about July 13, 1964 complainant ordered telephone service to be established by defendant at complainant's residence at 11492 West 87th Street, Los Angeles, California; that on July 15, 1964, defendant did not establish service as promised; that complainant was advised by defendant that service could not be established in complainant's residence due to previous removal of service pursuant to orders of the Los Angeles City Police Department; that complainant has no knowledge of activities at her residence prior to her occupancy on April 17, 1964; that complainant has not used and does not now intend to use any telephone facilities as instrumentalities to violate the law nor in aiding or abetting such violation; that complainant has made demand upon defendant to have said telephone facilities established, but defendant has refused and does now still refuse to do so; that complainant has suffered and will continue to suffer great hardship if deprived of said telephone facilities; that complainant's job and the illness of her father depend on the telephone service; that complainant seeks establishment of telephone facilities forthwith; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation, is hereby directed to establish telephone service to complainant and to maintain such service pending further Commission order herein, said service to be furnished pursuant to defendant's filed tariff rates and rules applicable thereto. The complaint will be set for hearing before such Commissioner or Examiner, and at such time and place, as may hereafter be designated.

The Secretary is directed as follows:

- 1. To cause a certified copy of this order, together with a copy of the complaint herein, to be served upon The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation, and said defendant is directed to serve and file its reply within ten (10) days after said service.
 - 2. To cause a copy of this order to be mailed to complainant.
- 3. To cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed to the parties at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing herein.
