OPINION

Pacific Power & Light Company, in this proceeding, requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the rights and privileges of a franchise granted by the Town of Etna, permitting the installation, maintenance and use of an electric distribution and transmission system upon the streets of said city.

The franchise referred to, a copy of which is attached to the application and designated as Exhibit A, was granted by the Town in accordance with the Franchise Act of 1937 and is of indeterminate duration. A fee is payable annually to the Town equivalent to 2 percent of the gross receipts arising from the use, operation, or possession of the franchise, but not less than 1 percent of the gross annual receipts from sales of electricity within the limits of the Town under said franchise and the constitutional franchise claimed by applicant for distribution of electricity throughout the Town for illuminating purposes.

The costs incurred by applicant in obtaining the franchise are stated to have been \$66.55, which amount does not include costs incident to this application.
