

ORIGINALDecision No. 67700

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Petition of the CITY OF NORTH SACRAMENTO to have fixed the just compensation to be paid for the municipal water system of CITIZENS UTILITIES COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA existing within and adjacent to the boundaries of said city.

Application No. 38629

Supplementary Petition of CITIZENS UTILITIES COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA for increase of the just compensation fixed by the Commission.

Supplementary Petition of the CITY OF NORTH SACRAMENTO under Section 1417 of the Public Utilities Code for a finding and order decreasing the total compensation fixed by the Commission's Decision No. 57344, dated September 15, 1958.

ORDER FIXING EFFECTIVE DATE

Decision No. 66762, issued on February 4, 1964, found that the just compensation to be paid by the City of North Sacramento to Citizens Utilities Company of California for the taking of certain properties, fixed by the Commission in 1958 (Decision No. 57344, 56 Cal.P.U.C. 554), should be increased by the sum of \$232,000. Petition for rehearing was filed in time to stay Decision No. 66762 pending Commission action on that petition. The order denying rehearing further stayed the effective date of Decision No. 66762 for a period of thirty days. Thereafter, because of the contemplated filing of a petition for writ of review, on May 7, 1964 the effective date of Decision No. 66762 was stayed pending further Commission order.

Writ of review was denied by the Supreme Court of California on July 22, 1964. (Citizens Utilities Company v Public Utilities Commission, S.F. No. 21696.) Time to apply for a rehearing in the Supreme Court having expired, IT IS ORDERED that the effective date of Decision No. 66762 is the date of this order fixing effective date.
