Supplementary Petition or CIIIZENS UTILITIES COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA for increase of the just compensation filxed by the Commission.

Supplementary Petition of the CITY OF NORME SACRAMENTO under Section 2417 of the Pubaic Utilities code for a finding and order decreasing the total compensation fixed by the Commssion's Decision No. 57344 , dated September 15 , 2958.

## ORDER FIXING EFFECTIVE DATE

Decision No. 66762, issued on February 4, 2964, found that the fust compensation to be paid by the City of North Sacramento to Citizens Utilities Company of Califormia for the taking of certain propertice, ilxed by the Commssion in 1958 (Decision No. 57344,56 Cal.P.U.C. 554 ), shoula be increased by the sum of $\$ 232,000$. "Petition for rehearing was inled in.time to stay Decision No. 66762 pending Commisaion action on that petition. The order denying rchearing further stayed the effective date of Decision No. 66762 for a period of thirty days. Thereafter, because of the contemplated filing of a petielon for writ of review, on May 7, 1964 the effective date of Decision No. 56762 was stayed pending furtiner Commission order.

Writ of review was denied by the Supreme Court of California on July 22, 1964. (citizens Utilities company v puibile Utilities Commission, S.F. No. 21696.) time to apply for a rehearing in the Supreme Court having expired, IT IS ORDERED that the effective date of Decision No. 66762 is the date of this order fixing effective date.
