Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with terms of an agreement to be entered into between the County of Crange and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the railway, shall be filed with the Commission prior to comencezent of construction. Should the parties fail to igree, the Comission xill apportion the costs of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorizaEion shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be
extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
