SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 67531, dated July 14, 1964, in the above proceedings, adopted Distance Table No. 5 as the basis for determining constructive mileages for use in applying distance rates in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2.

It has come to the Commission's attention that Decision No. 67531, supra, does not authorize highway common carriers to apply the constructive mileages set forth in Distance Table No. 5 to the distanœrates in their common carrier tariffs for the transportation of exempt commodities or other commodities which are subject to higher rates than, or more restrictive provisions than, the minimum rates or provisions otherwise applicable. The necessary correction will be made by the order herein.

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C. 5432 (Pet. 324), C. 7024 (Pet. 10) - ams

IT IS ORDERED that:

Decision No. 67531 dated July 14, 1964, in Cases Nos.
5432 and 7024 is amended by adding thereto Ordering Paragraph No. 3
(a) to read as follows:

3(a). Common carriers are hereby authorized to adopt Distance Table No. 5 as the basis for computing distances for use in applying distance rates in their common carrier tariffs for the transportation of:

- (1) commodities for which minimum rates have not been established, or
- (2) commodities which are subject to higher rates than, or more restrictive provisions than, the minimum rates or provisions otherwise applicable.

2. In all other respects, said Decision No. 31606, as amended, and Decision No. 67531 shall remain in full force and effect. This order shall become effective on the date hereof. Dated at San Francisco, California, this _____ day of August, 1964.
