Application of SAN DIEGO TRANSIT SYSTEM, a Corporation, for authority to revise certain of its school routes.

Application No. 46810  
(Filed July 15, 1964)

OPINION AND ORDER

By this application San Diego Transit System, a corporation, requests authority to make changes in the operation of its school routes to meet the needs of the students and to conform with local traffic requirements.

The San Diego Unified School District has informed this Commission that it has no objection to the proposed route changes. The Commission's staff reports that the re-routing of Routes Nos. 21 to 26, inclusive, and Routes Nos. 31, 32, 35, 39, 40 and 41 are necessary due to the construction of new schools and changes in traffic patterns.

No change in fares is contemplated and the matter is not controversial.

The Commission having considered the application finds that public convenience and necessity require that the routes hereinabove mentioned be re-routed as set forth in the appendix to this decision.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to San Diego Transit System, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a "passenger stage corporation", as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers between the points and over the routes set forth in Sixth Revised Page 3, Fourth Revised Page 34, Fourth Revised Page 35, Fourth Revised Page 36, First Revised Page 37, Third Revised Page 38, Third Revised Page 39, Third Revised Page 44, Fourth Revised Page 45, Third Revised Page 48, Third Revised Page 52, Third Revised Page 53, and Second Revised Page 54, attached hereto, as an extension and enlargement of, consolidation with and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in the certificate granted by Decision No. 55090, as amended.

2. Appendix A of Decision No. 55090, as amended, is hereby further amended by incorporating therein the above-revised pages, attached hereto, in revision of Fifth Revised Page 3, Third Revised Page 34, Third Revised Page 35, Third Revised Page 36, Original Page 37, Second Revised Page 38, Second Revised Page 39, Second Revised Page 44, Third Revised Page 45, Second Revised Page 48, Second Revised Page 52, Second Revised Page 53, and First Revised Page 54.

3. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file tariffs and timetables, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.
- (c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than ten days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the service herein authorized.
- (d) The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79 and 98.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.

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## Section 4. SCHOOL ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS

ROUTE "21" - CRAWFORD SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

- A. From the intersection of El Cajon Boulevard and College Avenue, loop via College Avenue, Montezuma Road, Campanile Drive, Hardy Avenue, 55th Street, Montezuma Road, and El Cajon Boulevard to College Avenue, then via El Cajon Boulevard to 56th Street, then loop via El Cajon Boulevard, 54th Street, 54th Place, Orange Avenue, Sharron Place, Trojan Avenue, and 56th Street to El Cajon Boulevard.
- B. From the intersection of 69th Street and Celia Vista Drive, via Celia Vista Drive, Rolando Boulevard, and El Cajon Boulevard to 56th Street, then loop via El Cajon Boulevard, 54th Street, 54th Place, Orange Avenue, Sharron Place, Trojan Avenue, and 56th Street to El Cajon Boulevard.
- C. From the intersection of University Avenue and College Avenue, via College Avenue, Streatview Drive, Glade Street, Thorn Street, Lynn Street, Streatview Drive, and 54th Street to 54th Place, then loop via 54th Place, Orange Avenue, Sharron Place, Trojan Avenue, and 54th Street to 54th Place.
- D. From the intersection of Haniman Drive and 54th Street, via 54th Street to 54th Place, then loop via 54th Place, Orange Avenue, Sharron Place, Trojan Avenue, and 54th Street to 54th Place.

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## Section 4. SCHOOL ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS (continued)

ROUTE "22" - HOOVER SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

- A. From the intersection of Juniper Street and 30th Street, via 30th Street, Upas Street, 30th Street, and El Cajon Boulevard to 45th Street.
- B. From the intersection of Bancroft Street and Kalmia Street, loop via Kalmia Street, 30th Street, Juniper Street, and Bancroft Street to Kalmia Street, then via Bancroft Street, Palm Street, McKinley Street, Thorn Street, Nile Street, and University Avenue to 43rd Street, then loop via University Avenue, Chamoune Avenue, El Cajon Boulevard, and 43rd Street to University Avenue.
- C. From the intersection of Louisiana Street and Adams Avenue, via Adams Avenue, Van Dyke Avenue, and El Cajon Boulevard to 45th Street.
- D. From the intersection of Eldridge Street and Waring Road, via Waring Road, Orcutt Avenue, 50th Street, Twain Avenue, Mission Gorge Road, and Fairmount Avenue to Monroe Avenue, then southbound only via 43rd Street and El Cajon Boulevard to Fairmount Avenue, then via El Cajon Boulevard to 45th Street.  
Also, from the intersection of El Cajon Boulevard and Fairmount Avenue, northbound only via Fairmount Avenue to Monroe Avenue.

ROUTE "23" - KEARNY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

- A. From the intersection of Shawn Avenue and Mission Village Drive, via Mission Village Drive, Gramercy Drive, Greyling Drive, Pinecrest Avenue, Afton Road, Aero Drive, and Linda Vista Road to Artillery Drive, then loop via Artillery Drive, Wellington Street, Korink Avenue, and Linda Vista Road to Artillery Drive.

ROUTE "24" - LA JOLLA SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL and MUIRLANDS JUNIOR  
HIGH SCHOOL

- A. From the intersection of Ventura Boulevard and Mission Boulevard, via Mission Boulevard, Turquoise Street, La Jolla Boulevard, and Nautilus Street to Avenida La Reina.
- B. From the intersection of Ingraham Street and Garnet Avenue, via Garnet Avenue, Fanuel Street, Turquoise Street, La Jolla Boulevard, and Nautilus Street to Avenida La Reina.

ROUTE "25" - LINCOLN SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

- A. From the intersection of 40th Street and Market Street, via Market Street, 47th Street, Federal Boulevard, Euclid Avenue, and Imperial Avenue to 49th Street.

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Section 4. SCHOOL ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS (continued)

ROUTE "26" - MISSION BAY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

- A. From the intersection of Ventura Boulevard and Mission Boulevard, via Mission Boulevard, Garnet Avenue, Morrell Street, and Grand Avenue to the school.

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## Section 4. SCHOOL ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS (continued)

ROUTE "31" - GOMPERS JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

- A. From the intersection of 47th Street and Market Street, via Market Street, Merlin Drive, Imperial Avenue, Euclid Avenue, Logan Avenue, 45th Street, Ocean View Boulevard, and 47th Street to Hilltop Drive.

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## Section 4. SCHOOL ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS (continued)

ROUTE "32" - EINSTEIN JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

- A. From the intersection of Clairemont Drive and Clairemont Mesa Boulevard, via Clairemont Mesa Boulevard to Diane Avenue, then loop via Clairemont Mesa Boulevard, Longford Street, Conrad Avenue, and Diane Avenue to Clairemont Mesa Boulevard.

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## Section 4. SCHOOL ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS (continued)

ROUTE "35" - WILSON JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

- A. From the intersection of Tulip Street and Pepper Drive, loop via Pepper Drive, 39th Street, Gateway Drive, Rexford Drive, and Tulip Street to Pepper Drive, then via Pepper Drive, Violet Street, Poplar Street, Fairmount Avenue, and Orange Avenue to 43rd Street, then loop via Orange Avenue, 37th Street, El Cajon Boulevard, and 43rd Street to Orange Avenue.
- B. From the intersection of Louisiana Street and Adams Avenue, via Adams Avenue, Cherokee Avenue, Meade Avenue, and 37th Street to El Cajon Boulevard, then eastbound only via El Cajon Boulevard to 38th Street. Also, from the intersection of 38th Street and Orange Avenue, westbound only via Orange Avenue and 37th Street to El Cajon Boulevard.
- C. From the intersection of Juniper Street and 30th Street, via 30th Street, Upas Street, 30th Street, and El Cajon Boulevard to 37th Street, then eastbound only via El Cajon Boulevard to 38th Street. Also, from the intersection of 38th Street and Orange Avenue, westbound only via Orange Avenue and 37th Street to El Cajon Boulevard.
- D. From the intersection of Bancroft Street and Kalmia Street, loop via Kalmia Street, 30th Street, Juniper Street, and Bancroft Street to Kalmia Street, then via Bancroft Street, Palm Street, McKinley Street, Thorn Street, Nile Street, and University Avenue to 37th Street, then loop via University Avenue, 39th Street, Orange Avenue, and 37th Street to University Avenue.

ROUTE "39" - MANN JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

- A. From the intersection of El Cajon Boulevard and College Avenue, loop via College Avenue, Montezuma Road, Campanile Drive, Hardy Avenue, 55th Street, Montezuma Road, and El Cajon Boulevard to College Avenue, then via El Cajon Boulevard to 56th Street, then loop via 56th Street, Trojan Avenue, 54th Street, and El Cajon Boulevard to 56th Street.
- B. From the intersection of 69th Street and Celia Vista Drive, via Celia Vista Drive, Rolando Boulevard, and El Cajon Boulevard to 56th Street, then loop via 56th Street, Trojan Avenue, 54th Street, and El Cajon Boulevard to 56th Street.
- C. From the intersection of University Avenue and College Avenue, via College Avenue, Streamview Drive, Glade Street, Thorn Street, Lynn Street, Streamview Drive, and 54th Street to 54th Place, then loop via 54th Place, Orange Avenue, Sharron Place, Trojan Avenue, and 54th Street to 54th Place.
- D. From the intersection of Haniman Drive and 54th Street, via 54th Street to 54th Place, then loop via 54th Place, Orange Avenue, Sharron Place, Trojan Avenue, and 54th Street to 54th Place.

ROUTE "40" - O'FARRELL JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

- A. From the intersection of Olvera Avenue and Euclid Avenue, via Euclid Avenue, Imperial Avenue, Merlin Drive, Market Street, Iona Drive, Kenwood Street, 60th Street, Broadway, 65th Street, Imperial Avenue, Lisbon Street, Jamacha Road, Cardiff Street, San Vicente Street, Sawtelle Avenue, Skyline Drive, 65th Street, and Detroit Avenue to 61st Street.

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## Section 4. SCHOOL ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS (continued)

ROUTE "41" - ACADEMY OF OUR LADY OF PEACE

- A. From the intersection of Oregon Street and Collier Avenue, westbound only via Collier Avenue, Arizona Street, Adams Avenue, Park Boulevard, University Avenue, 1st Avenue, Ivy Street, 2nd Avenue, Ash Street, Front Street, and Broadway to 4th Avenue.
- B. From the intersection of Collier Avenue and Oregon Street, southbound only via Oregon Street, Madison Avenue, Texas Street, U. S. Highway 80 and access roads to the Mission Valley Shopping Center, then via U. S. Highway 80 and access roads, Taylor Street, and Rosecrans Street to Lowell Street.

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
