OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant holds highway contract and city carrier permits. By Decision No. 67063 dated April 7, 1964, in Application No. 45431, applicant was authorized to transport grain or rice flour and semolina or semolina and grain flour in bulk between points within the Los Angeles Drayage Area for specified shippers. Applicant seeks to amend the authority to include Barbara Ann Baking Co. as a specified shipper.

Applicant avers that it has been requested by Barbara Ann Baking Co. to transport flour in bulk between points and places in the Los Angeles Drayage Area on the same basis as authorized by Decision No. 67063, supra, for other shippers. Applicant states that this shipper would be placed at a serious competitive disadvantage should it continue to be excluded from the order as set forth in the aforementioned decision. It is asserted that the transportation circumstances of this shipper's traffic are the same as for the other shippers involved and the additional operations for the account of Barbara Ann Baking Co. will be profitable.

The certificate of service shows that a copy of the application was mailed to California Trucking Association on July 31, 1964. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed amendment is reasonable and consistent with the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 67063 dated April 7, 1964, in Application No. 45431 is hereby amended by adding to the list of milling companies set forth in Appendix A attached to said Decision No. 67063 and thereby made a part thereof Barbara Ann Baking Co.

2. In all other respects, Decision No. 67063 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
