"36. A-46439, 43-5620, T-69,563, Carl T. Heaton, Merced; and independent contractor subhauling operations only to and within the following counties: Alameda, Butte, Contra Costa, Fresno, Kings, Mariposa, Mendocino, Monterey, Napa, Placer, Plumas, San Francisco, San Joaquin, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Siskiyou, Solano, Sonoma, Stanislaus, Yolo and Sacramento."

Rehearing of said resolution, as amended, is denied.
