OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 66745, dated February 4, 1964, M & W Bus Lines, Inc., a corporation, was granted a charter-party permit conditioned upon first filing with this Commission (1) a vehicle inspection report of California Highway Patrol, (2) medical certificates for all of its drivers, and (3) annual financial report for 1963.

On March 3, 1964, the annual report was filed.

On July 7, 1964, M & W Bus Lines, Inc., was authorized to sell its certificated passenger stage operative rights to Clyde O. Mussack (Decision No. 67480).

On June 17, 1964, applicant's president, Eugene Stracner, was notified by the Commission's staff that unless the vehicle inspection report and medical certificates were filed with this Commission on or before July 30, 1964, the charter-party permit granted by Decision No. 66745 would be canceled.

Applicant having failed to comply with the provisions of said decision and subsequent notice and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the charter-party permit issued pursuant to Decision No. 66745, in Application No. 45746, be and it is hereby rescinded and revoked.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
