authorizing construction of a crossing at
separated grades over the tracks of the
Southern Pacific Company in connection
with the construction of San Tomas
Expressway in Santa Clara County.

O R D E R

County of Santa Clara is hereby authorized to construct San Tomas Expressway at separated grades over the track of Southern Pacific Company, in Santa Clara, Santa Clara County, at the location and substantially as shown by map and plans (Exhibits B, C and D) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-42.5-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years, unless

time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
