OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 sets forth zone rates for the transportation of rock products by for-hire carriers from defined production areas to designated delivery zones within certain areas of California.

By this petition the California Dump Truck Owners Association, Inc., seeks extension of the zone system of rates which is applicable within portions of Los Angeles, Orange and Ventura Counties to apply to shipments of rock products and asphaltic concrete from rock and asphaltic concrete processing facilities that have recently been established by Blue Diamond Corporation and Industrial Asphalt, respectively, in the vicinity of Castaic Junction.

Petitioner states that said companies expect to ship several thousand tons of rock products and asphaltic concrete from the new facilities each month; that they will use the services of

for-hire dump truck carriers for the transportation involved; that the minimum rates which apply at present for said transportation are hourly rates and distance rates; that said rates are not satisfactory bases of transportation charges for the traffic; that competing producers are able to ship under zone rates, and that extension of the zone system of rates as sought would avoid undue rate discrimination against Blue Diamond's and Industrial Asphalt's shipments.

The petition sets forth time and mileage data needed for the calculation of zone rates into Los Angeles County.<sup>1</sup> It also contains a sketch and territorial description of the area which encompasses the new facilities and which would be designated as a production area in conjunction with extension of the zone rates.

An inspection of the proposed production area was made by a representative of the Transportation Division of the Commission's staff. The report on this inspection is incorporated in the record in this matter as Exhibit No. 2. In the report the staff's representative recommends boundaries for the proposed production area which are different from those proposed by petitioner. The changes in boundary description are recommended for purposes of clarity. Said changes are acceptable to petitioner.

<sup>1</sup> Petitioner also submitted certain supplementary data by letter. Said data are made part of the record in this matter as Exhibit No. 1. In addition Blue Diamond Company submitted a list of the zones which comprises its marketing area. This list was submitted to designate the zones for which zone rates are sought. Said list is made part of this record as Exhibit No. 3.

It is clear from the petition that extension of the zone rates as proposed would do no more than provide, from the new point of production, rates of the same kind and character as are available from competing rock producing facilities in the same general area. To deny the sought extension of the zone rates would be to deprive the Blue Diamond Company and Industrial Asphalt of a basis of rates heretofore established as reasonable for competing shippers.

In the circumstances the Commission finds that, subject to the modifications in boundaries recommended by the representative of the Commission's Transportation Division, the extension of zone rates, as proposed by petitioner in this matter, to apply to shipments of rock products and related materials from the new facilities of Blue Diamond Company and Industrial Asphalt has been shown to be justified, and that such action will result in the application of just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates and charges to said shipments. The petition will be granted insofar as it relates to the establishment of zone rates into Los Angeles County. A similar request on behalf of Industrial Asphalt for the establishment of certain zone rates into Ventura County will be denied for lack of sufficient supporting data. Public hearing on the petition is not necessary.

The rates presently shown in the tariff from Los Angeles County Production Area XX to various Los Angeles County delivery zones which are under suspension by Supplement No. 19 will be eliminated in the interests of tariff simplification.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 (Appendix "A" to Decision No. 32566, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective November 7, 1964, the revised tariff pages listed in Appendix A attached hereto.

2. In all other respects said Decision No. 32566, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

3. Except as is otherwise provided herein, Petition No. 96 in Case No. 5437 is hereby denied.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
