OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 67494 dated July 8, 1964, and on petition of E. & J. Gallo Winery, rates were established in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 14-A for the statewide transportation of "Pomace, not fit for human consumption."

By letter dated September 24, 1964, E. & J. Gallo Winery requests modification of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 14-A for transportation of "Pomace, not fit for human consumption," in bulk, established by Decision No. 67494 dated July 8, 1964. It states that it did not intend to seek the establishment of rates for the transportation of pomace to the field for agricultural purposes. Gallo now requests that this transportation be excluded, and that immediate revision of the tariff be accomplished to accommodate the grape harvest now in progress.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that petitioner's proposed further revision is justified. A public hearing is not necessary. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 14-A will be amended accordingly by the order herein.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 14-A (Appendix A to Decision No. 67397, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective October 1, 1964, Second Revised Page 31 and First Revised Page 31-A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the first day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff page incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects said Decision No. 67397, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
