Item No.	SECTION NO. 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Continued)
20	Rates provided in this tariff are minimum rates, established pursuant to the Highway Carriers' Act. and the City Carriers' Act. They apply for transportation of property by radial highway common carriers and highway contract carriers, as defined in said Highway Carriers' Act, and by carriers as defined in said City Carriers' Act, in bulk in dump truck equipment. Except as otherwise provided in Items Nos. 45, 93 and 94 rates, rules and regulations named in this tariff shall not apply to transportation by underlying carriers (independent-contractor subhaulers) when such transportation is performed for other carriers. This exception shall not be construed to exempt from the tariff provisions carriers for whom the underlying carriers are performing transportation service.
ø25	APPLICATION OF TARIFF - GENERAL **Rates in this tariff do not apply to the transportation of: (a) Property of the United States or property transported under an agreement whereby the United States contracted for the carrier's service. **(b) Disaster Supplies, i.e., those commodities which are allocated to provide relief during a state of extreme emergency or state of disaster; and those commodities which are transported for a civil defense or disaster organization established and functioning in accordance with the California Disaster Act to ultimate point of storage or use prior to or during a state of disaster or state of extreme emergency. For rates for the transportation of commodities in dump truck equipment, other than as provided in this tariff, see City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B, 2, 5 or 9-B, as the case may be.
30	APPLICATION OF TARIFF - TERRITORIAL Rates in this tariff apply for transportation between all points within the State of California.
35	REFERENCES TO ITEMS AND OTHER TARIFFS Unless otherwise provided, references herein to item numbers in this or other tariffs include references to such numbers with letter suffix, and references to other tariffs include references to amendments and successive issues of such other tariffs.

COMPUTATION OF DISTANCES

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Distances to be used in connection with distance rates named herein shall be the actual mileages traversed, including any detour to and from scales to obtain weight of shipment.
