O R D E R

City of Costa Mesa is hereby authorized to construct
 Gisler Avenue at grade across an industrial drill track in the City
 of Costa Mesa, Orange County, at the location described in the appli-
 cation to be identified as Crossing No. 6N-40.14-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance
 cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The
 Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost of the
 crossing between such lines.

Width of the crossing shall be 40 feet and grades of approach
 not greater than two percent in accordance with plan attached to the
 application. Construction at the crossing shall be equal or superior
 to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by
 two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order,
 applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authoriza-
 tion shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be
 extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization
 may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety
 so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
