Width of the crossing shall be 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Construction at the crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flasking light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Comission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.
