Application of the State of California,
 Department of Public Works, for an order
 authorizing construction of a crossing
 at separated grades whereby State Route
 VI-Fre-41 will be carried over the tracks
 of the Southern Pacific Company in the
 City of Fresno, referred to as "South
 Fresno Viaduct".

ORDER

State of California, Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct State Route VI-Fre-41 at separated grades over the track of Southern Pacific Company in Fresno, Fresno County, at the location and substantially as shown by map (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-206.3-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G.O. 26-D, except that vertical clearances shall be not less than 24 feet 2 inches in accordance with plan attached to the application.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years,

unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
