ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

David Treguboff, doing business as Service Cold Storage Co., possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman at Alhambra. He has informed the Commission staff that his public utility warehouse operations have been discontinued.

David Treguboff having discontinued service without first having obtained authority to do so, and the Commission finding that such discontinuance constitutes good cause for the revocation of the prescriptive operative right involved and cancellation of the tariff applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive public utility warehouse operative right of David Treguboff, doing business as Service Cold Storage Co., as determined by the Commission's order dated August 1, 1960, in Case No. 6741, is hereby revoked.

2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of David Treguboff, doing business as Service Cold Storage Co., from his California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Cold Storage Warehouse Tariff No. 2-H, Cal.P.U.C. No. 210, on file with the Commission, within ninety days after the effective date of this order and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made on David Treguboff, or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records, and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon David Treguboff or after the above mailing to David Treguboff, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
