ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Frank D. Brothers possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman in Stratford. The Trustee for Frank Brothers, Bankrupt, has informed us that Frank D. Brothers has discontinued public utility warehouse operations. Moreover, he failed to file an annual report for 1962-63 fiscal year.

Frank D. Brothers having failed to file an annual report and having apparently discontinued the public utility warehouse operations herein involved without proper authority, and the Commission finding that such failure and discontinuance of service constitute good causes for revocation of the prescriptive operative right involved and cancellation of the tariff applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman determined for Frank D. Brothers, doing business as Frank Brothers Company, by order of the Commission, dated August 9, 1960, in Case No. 6800, is hereby revoked.

2. Frank Brothers Company (Frank Brothers) Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, is hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Frank D. Brothers or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Frank D. Brothers or after the above mailing to Frank D. Brothers, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
