ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Sierra Distributing, Ltd., has requested revocation of its prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman at Florin and vicinity. The letter states that the company has not conducted operations as a public warehouseman since September 1, 1959.

The Commission's records show that Sierra Distributing, Ltd., never has filed an annual report of public utility warehouse operations as required by Section 584 of the Public Utilities Code.

Sierra Distributing, Ltd., having failed to file annual reports and having discontinued the public utility warehouse operations herein involved without proper authority, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure and discontinuance constitute good cause for revocation of the prescriptive operative right involved and of the tariff applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The public utility warehouse operative right of Sierra Distributing, Ltd., as determined by order dated August 30, 1960, in Case No. 6915, is hereby revoked.

2. C. R. Nickerson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of Sierra Distributing, Ltd., from his Pacific Coast Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal. P.U.C. No. 1, on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made on Sierra Distributing, Ltd., or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to C. R. Nickerson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Sierra Distributing, Ltd., or after the above mailing to Sierra Distributing, Ltd., as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for a public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
