ORDER CHANGING NAME

Jake's Trucking Company, a corporation, has authority to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of general commodities, with certain exceptions, between points and places in Los Angeles and Orange Counties.

By an amendment of its Articles of Incorporation filed with the Secretary of State on September 15, 1964, the company's corporate name was changed to Falcon Freight. Its operating certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name.

A public hearing is not necessary.

The carrier is required by Rule 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A to amend its tariffs immediately to show the new name of the company.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 65886, dated August 20, 1963, is amended by substituting "Falcon Freight" in place and stead of "Jake's Trucking Company."
