ORDER VACATING ORDER SETTING HEARING

By Order Setting Hearing dated November 12, 1963, in Case No. 5432, the Commission ordered that a hearing be held for the receipt of evidence concerning rates, charges and rules governing diverted, reconsigned or returned shipments and related matters under Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2.

A limited study of the matter by the Commission's Rate Branch staff discloses that it will be necessary to conduct a major study on this subject. Current demands for staff studies in connection with more pressing and important matters make it impractical to proceed with such a study at this time.

Upon consideration of the particular circumstances here present, the Commission concludes that this order setting hearing should be vacated.

IT IS ORDERED that Order Setting Hearing dated November 12, 1963, in Case No. 5432, be vacated and set aside.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
