IT IS ORDERED that Sub. No. 44 on page 5 of the attachment to Resolution No. 13821 be amended to read as follows:
"44. A-46453, T-69,364, LES CAIKINS TRUCKING, INC., Alameda, Amador, Butte, Fresno, Kern, Madera, Mendocino, Merced, Napa, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, San Joaquin, Shasta, and Yolo."
