ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHT

V. R. Anderson, doing business as V. R. Anderson Truck Co., possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of property between Los Angeles Territory and San Diego Territory and between Oceanside, on the one hand, and all points and places in Los Angeles, Orange and San Diego Counties, on the other hand. The carrier's participation in Western Classification 78 was canceled effective May 6, 1964, by Supplement 7 thereto.

By letter from the Secretary of the Commission, V. R. Anderson was placed on notice that his certificate would be subject to suspension or revocation, pursuant to lawful procedures, should he fail to maintain a classification in effect. V. R. Anderson has not filed a classification to replace the canceled classification.

Section 493 of the Code provides that no common carrier shall engage or participate in the transportation of property until its schedules of rates and classification have been filed.

The required classification not being on file, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for the suspension of this carrier's certificate, and

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to V. R. Anderson by Decision No. 54648 dated March 12, 1957, as amended by Decision No. 63042 dated January 9, 1962, in Application No. 35955 is hereby suspended pending further order.

2. All otherwise effective tariff schedules of such carrier filed pursuant to the certificate granted and amended by the decisions referred to above are hereby suspended. Suspension supplements to tariff filings so suspended are not required and shall not be filed.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon V. R. Anderson or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after such service upon V. R. Anderson, or after the above mailing to V. R. Anderson, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for a public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
