ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHT

Vernon W. Bolen possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of property between Santa Barbara and Thousand Oaks and intermediate points via U. S. Highway 101, including the off-route points of Point Hueneme, Oxnard, Saticoy and Somis; between Ventura and Ojai, and intermediate points via U. S. Highway 399 and State Highway 150; and between Ventura and Fillmore, and intermediate points via State Highway 126. The carrier's participation in Western Classification 78 was canceled effective May 6, 1964, by Supplement 7 thereto.

By letter from the Secretary of the Commission, Vernon W. Bolen was placed on notice that his certificate would be subject to suspension or revocation, pursuant to lawful procedures, should he fail to maintain a classification in effect. Vernon W. Bolen has not filed a classification to replace the canceled classification.

Section 493 of the Code provides that no common carrier shall engage or participate in the transportation of property until its schedules of rates and classifications have been filed.

The required classification not being on file and the Commission finding that such failure constitutes good cause for the suspension of this carrier's certificate,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Vernon W. Bolen by Decision No. 54592 dated February 25, 1957, in Application No. 36260 is hereby suspended pending further order.
- 2. All otherwise effective tariff schedules of such carrier filed pursuant to the certificate granted by the decision referred to above are hereby suspended. Suspension supplements to tariff filings so suspended are not required and shall not be filed.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Vernon W. Bolen or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after such service upon Vernon W. Bolen, or after the above mailing to Vernon W. Bolen, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for a public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
