ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity of Paul Burnette, doing business as Burnette Freight Lines, has been suspended since August 19, 1964, for failure to have on file requisite evidence of liability insurance. He has informed the Commission staff that he does not intend to operate under the certificate and by written request asks that it be revoked.

Paul Burnette having failed to have on file the required evidence of liability insurance and having discontinued service as a highway common carrier without proper authority, the Commission finds that such failure and discontinuance constitute good cause for the revocation of the certificate involved and cancellation of the tariffs applicable to the services thereunder, and

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Paul Burnette by Decision No. 52424, dated December 28, 1955, in Application No. 37297 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs on file with the Commission in the name of Paul Burnette are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Paul Burnette or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Paul Burnette or after the above mailing to Paul Burnette, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
