ORDER

City of Los Alamitos is hereby authorized to construct Bloomfield Street at grade across two spur tracks of the Stanton Huntington Beach Branch of the Pacific Electric Railway Company, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6NC-28.66-C, in the City of Los Alamitos, County of Orange.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction expense, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails on each track. The Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear the maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines on each track.

Width of the crossing over the northerly and southerly spur tracks shall be 30 feet and 40 feet respectively and grades of approach not greater than two percent, in accordance with plans attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
