ORDER OF MODIFICATION

By Decision No. 67839, dated September 15, 1964, the  
 Commission authorized United States Express to sell its operating  
 rights to Garrett Freightlines, Inc., on or before December 1, 1964.

The applicants filed a petition on October 6, 1964, to advise that the matter is still pending before the Interstate Commerce Commission on the application to transfer the interstate operating authority of United States Express and to request that the time within which to transfer the rights be extended to June 1, 1965, so the decision of the Interstate Commerce Commission will be issued before it becomes necessary to transfer the California operating authority of United States Express.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 2 of Decision No. 67839 should be amended to read as follows:

"2. On or before June 1, 1965, United States Express may sell and transfer, and Garrett Freightlines, Inc., may purchase and acquire, the operative rights and property referred to in the application."

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
