

The certificate of service shows that a copy of the application was served upon the shipper, upon California Trucking Association and upon other known interested parties. No objection to its being granted has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds that the proposed rate is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The application, as amended, will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Post Transportation Company, a corporation, is hereby authorized to transport common salt, in bulk, in dump truck equipment for Stauffer Chemical Company from Pier A, Long Beach, to the plant of Stauffer Chemical Company at Dominguez at a rate less than the minimum rate established for such transportation but not less than 3-3/4 cents per 100 pounds, subject to a minimum weight per truckload of 50,000 pounds.

2. The authority herein granted shall, on and after December 1, 1964, supersede the authority granted by Decision No. 66349 and shall expire with December 1, 1965.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
