The operative effect of Decision No. 64908 was stayed "pending further order herein" because of the pendency of a petition for writ of review before the California Supreme Court. Review was denied. (Alhambra Trucking Co. v Pub. Ut. Comm., S.F.No.21440.) Thereafter an appeal to the United States Supreme Court was dismissed for want of a substantial federal question. (Alhambra Trucking Co. v Pub. Ut. Comm., October Term, 1964, No. 288.)
