Because of the pendency of a petition for writ of review, the operative effect of Decision No. 64901 was stayed "pending further order of this Commission." Review was denied by the California Supreme Court. (Connolly et al. v Pub. Ut. Comm., S.F. No. 21334.) Appeal to the United States Supreme Court was dismissed for want of a substantial federal question. (Alhambra Trucking Co. and T. T. Connolly et al. v Pub. Ut. Comm., October Term, 1964, No. 288.)
