ORDER REVOKING OPERATING AUTHORITY  
AND DISCONTINUING INVESTIGATION

This proceeding was instituted on June 10, 1964, following an investigation by the Commission staff, for the purpose of determining whether the respondent in the operation of his transportation business pursuant to Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 19-56074 and City Carrier Permit No. 19-56075, may have violated Sections 3664 and 3667 of the Public Utilities Code in that he did directly or indirectly pay a commission or refund or did remit a portion of the rates or charges established in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 2 and 5 without first having obtained Commission authority.

Hearing in this matter was set for October 7, 1964, but was removed from the hearing calendar upon receipt of letter dated September 17, 1964, from the respondent requesting the permits issued to him be cancelled because he ceased transportation operation in California and moved to Utah. The staff of the Commission has verified that the respondent no longer resides or is operating a transportation business in California.

In the circumstances, the order which follows will revoke the permits held by the respondent, and the proceeding herein will be discontinued.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 19-56074 and City Carrier Permit No. 19-56075 issued to Charles H. Mitchell are revoked on the effective date of this order.

2. The investigation in Case No. 7920 is discontinued.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
