ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Alexander's Van and Storage, Inc., a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman at Santa Rosa. The warehouseman has informed the Commission by letter that it has not stored property other than household furniture since July of 1962 and requests that its warehouse tariff and prescriptive operative right be canceled.

In the circumstances, it appears and the Commission finds, that the revocation of the aforementioned prescriptive operative right will not be adverse to the public interest. The operative right will be revoked and the tariff applicable to the services thereunder will be canceled. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Alexander's Van and Storage, Inc., a corporation, as determined by order dated August 1, 1960, in Case No. 6712, is hereby revoked.
- 2. Alexander's Van and Storage, Inc. Warehouse Tariff Cal.P.U.C. No. 1 is hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Alexander's Van and Storage, Inc., unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
