ORDER OF MODIFICATION

By Decision No. 67932, dated September 30, 1964, the Commission authorized Lawson Taylor Lines, Inc., to sell its operating rights to Wells Cargo, Inc., on or before January 1, 1965. The applicants filed a petition on October 5, 1964, advising that the application made to the Interstate Commerce Commission to transfer the interstate operating authority of Lawson Taylor Lines, Inc. is pending and requesting that the time within which to transfer the rights be extended to June 1, 1965, so the decision of the Interstate Commerce Commission will be issued before it becomes necessary to transfer the California operating authority of Lawson Taylor Lines, Inc.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 2 of Decision No. 67932 should be amended to read as follows:

"2. On or before June 1, 1965, Lawson Taylor Lines, Inc. may sell and transfer, and Wells Cargo, Inc. may purchase and acquire the operative rights and property referred to in the application."

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
