



performed by such warehouseman. We find that the proposed rates will be reasonable for services performed by Dart Public Warehouse, Inc., and that to the extent such rates will result in increases, such increases are justified. We conclude that the order in Decision No. 67970 should be modified by substituting for Ordering Paragraph 3 of said decision the ordering paragraph set forth in the order which follows.

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the following ordering paragraph is substituted for Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision No. 67970 in Application No. 46878:

"3. Dart Public Warehouse, Inc., is authorized to publish and file with this Commission rates and charges on the levels set forth in California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 28-A (Cal. P.U.C. No. 193 of Agent Jack L. Dawson) as governed by California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 29-A (Cal. P.U.C. No. 194 of Agent Jack L. Dawson). The tariff filings authorized herein shall be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the consummation of the transfer herein authorized. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the

regulations governing the construction and filing  
of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General  
Order No. 61-A."

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
