SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

Decision No. 67970, dated October 6, 1964, in this proceeding authorized the sale and transfer of a prescriptive warehouse operative right in the City of Vernon from R-B Corporation, doing business as Commercial Transfer, to Dart Public Warehouse, Inc. In the application Dart Public Warehouse, Inc., proposed to establish the rates and charges for its warehouse services set forth in California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariffs Nos. 28 and 29-A, in lieu of adopting the rates maintained by its predecessor. Inadvertently, the order in Decision No. 67970 did not authorize Dart to publish rates as sought in the application.

The rate levels sought by applicant are those generally applicable to the storage of general commodities by the preponderance of the public utility warehouseman operating within Vernon and the adjacent portions of the City of Los Angeles; and such rates previously have been found reasonable for the services

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Paragraph 3 of said decision the ordering paragraph set forth in

the order which follows.

IT IS ORDERED that the following ordering paragraph is substituted for Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision No. 67970 in Application No. 46878:

"3. Dart Public Warehouse, Inc., is authorized to publish and file with this Commission rates and charges on the levels set forth in California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 28-A (Cal. P.U.C. No. 193 of Agent Jack L. Dawson) as governed by California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 29-A (Cal. P.U.C. No. 194 of Agent Jack L. Dawson). The tariff filings authorized herein shall be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the consummation of the transfer herein authorized. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the

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regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61-A."
