ORDER OF DISMISSAL OF PETITION FOR MODIFICATION

The above application was filed on October 29, 1962, and granted February 5, 1963 by Decision No. 64889. Subsequently on October 14, 1963, applicant filed a Petition for Modification of the above decision requesting that crossing protection be changed from two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals to two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. This petition was opposed by the Southern Pacific Company. Applicant was notified by letter dated September 22, 1964 that unless requested otherwise within thirty days, the Petition for Modification would be dismissed. Thirty days have now elapsed and no request has been filed by applicant.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Petition for Modification is hereby dismissed without prejudice.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
