FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 67813 dated September 4, 1964, in the above entitled proceeding, applicant, City of Union City, was authorized to construct two public roads at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company in Union City, Alameda County, to be identified as Crossings Nos. L-25.63-C and L-25.55-C.

The identification of these crossings being incorrect and good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Crossings Nos. L-25.63-C and L-25.55-C as indicated in Decision No. 67813, be changed to read Crossings Nos. L-26.3-C and L-26.4-C, respectively.

In all other respects, Decision No. 67813 shall remain in full force and effect.
