ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

By Resolution No. 13823, Sub. No. 21, dated June 23, 1964, in this proceeding, A. V. Cement Transport, Inc., was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a cement carrier to and within Kern, Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties from any and all points of origin. Among other things, the resolution ordered that, in providing service pursuant to the certificate therein granted, applicant shall file with the Commission tariffs in triplicate on or before October 1, 1964. The required tariffs have not been filed.

Section 486 of the Public Utilities Code requires that common carriers of property file with this Commission schedules showing their rates and classifications and Section 493 of the Code provides that no common carrier shall engage or participate in the transportation of property until its schedules of rates and classifications have been filed.

A. V. Cement Transport, Inc., having failed to have on file the required tariff schedules, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for the revocation of the certificate, and

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a cement carrier granted to A. V. Cement Transport, Inc., by Resolution No. 13823, Sub. No. 21, dated June 23, 1964, in Application No. 46430, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon A. V. Cement Transport, Inc., or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon A. V. Cement Transport, Inc., or after the above mailing to A. V. Cement Transport, Inc., as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
