ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

By Resolution No. 13825, Sub. No. 11, dated June 23, 1964, Clinton G. Reeder was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a cement carrier to and within Santa Clara County from any and all points of origin. Among other things, the resolution ordered that, in providing service pursuant to the certificate therein granted, applicant shall file with the Commission tariffs in triplicate on or before October 1, 1964. The required tariffs have not been filed.

Section 486 of the Public Utilities Code requires that common carriers of property file with this Commission schedules showing their rates and classifications and Section 493 of the Code provides that no common carrier shall engage or participate in the transportation of property until its schedules of rates and classifications have been filed.

Clinton G. Reeder having failed to have on file the required tariff schedules, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for the revocation of the certificate, and

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a cement carrier granted to Clinton G. Reeder by Resolution No. 13825, Sub. No. 11, dated June 23, 1964, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Clinton G. Reeder or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Clinton G. Reeder or after the above mailing to Clinton G. Reeder, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
