ORDER RESCINDING DECISION

Decision No. 64537, issued November 8, 1962, granted applicant an interim certificate, to be made final after the securing of proper authority from the Atomic Energy Commission, for the installation of Unit No. 1 at applicant's Bodega Bay Atomic Park. On November 4, 1964 applicant asked permission to withdraw its application to obtain the Atomic Energy Commission's authority to build that unit.

On December 3, 1964 applicant advised this Commission as follows:

"We do not intend to exercise the authorization granted us by your Decision No. 64537 and therefore request that such authorization now be terminated."

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 64537 is hereby rescinded and the authorization granted therein is terminated.
