

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

James B. Mohlmann, Jr., filed this complaint alleging his dissatisfaction with certain aspects of telephone service provided to him by California Water & Telephone Company at his residence, 9617 Ruffner Street, Sepulveda, California. The day previous to the date upon which this complaint was filed, complainant appeared before this Commission as a public witness in hearings held in San Fernando, California, in Case No. 7452 (Investigation on the Commission's Own Motion into the Rates, Tolls, Rules, Charges, Operations, Practices, Contracts, Service and Facilities of California Water & Telephone Company in its Monrovia, San Fernando, and Sierra Madre Exchanges), and at such time and place testified in detail regarding complaints which he had with the quality of telephone service he was receiving from defendant at the same address in Sepulveda, California, referred to in this complaint. Defendant prepared and filed a report in

said Case No. 7452 setting forth the results of its investigation and action taken to remedy such complaints.

On November 4, 1963, defendant filed its answer to this complaint, requesting dismissal. Complainant moved from defendant's telephone service area on May 2, 1964 at which time the service furnished by defendant to complainant was disconnected. By reason of such move and termination of service, the matters of which complaint was made have been rendered moot.

Complainant has failed to respond to written request from this Commission concerning the setting of this complaint for hearing and defendant has filed a petition herein for an ex parte order dismissing the complaint. We find that the complaint in Case No. 7714 should be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint in Case No. 7714 is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
