SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Case No. 7024

Distance Table No. 5 was established by Decision No. 66578, dated January 7, 1964, in this proceeding. It has come to the Commission's attention that the distance table contains certain errors and omissions and that clarification of the constructive mileage determination from or to certain incorporated cities, extended areas and other points is required. The necessary corrections and revisions will be made by the order herein.

IT IS ORDERED that:

California (including, but not limited to, constructive mileages provided in the)

Distance Table).

- 1. Distance Table No. 5 (Decision No. 66578, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective January 23, 1965, Supplement No. 3 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than January 23, 1965.

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- 3. Common carriers are authorized to adopt Supplement No. 3 to Distance Table No. 5 as a basis for computing distances for use in applying distance rates in their common carrier tariffs for the transportation of:
 - (a) commodities for which minimum rates have not been established, or
 - (b) commodities which are subject to higher rates than, or more restrictive provisions than, the minimum rates or provisions otherwise applicable.
- 4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rules authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rules published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
- 5. In all other respects said Decision No. 66578, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
