SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 68359 , issued today, the Commission established Minimum Rate Tariff No. 16, which sets forth minimum-rates, rules and regulations for the transportation of houses and other buildings including their contents, within and between defined areas in southern California. The decision states that, when transported subject to the provisions of said Minimum Rate Tariff No. 16, the contents of houses and other buildings will not be subject to the provisions of other of the Commission's minimum rate tariffs. It further states that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, each tariff should be amended by separate order. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32504, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein,

to become effective January 23, 1965, Second Revised Page 13-A, which page is attached hereto and by this reference is made a part hereof.

2. In all other respects said Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days
after the date hereof.

SECTION NO. 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS OF GENERAL APPLICATION (Continued)

APPLICATION OF TARIFF-COMMODITIES (Concluded) (Items Nos. 40 and 41)

Rates in this tariff apply for the transportation of all commodities except the following:

*Houses, as defined in Minimum Rate Tariff 16, or sections thereof, and integral parts or contents, when transported therewith.

Jewelry transported from or to wholesale houses in packages weighing 10 pounds or less,

Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semiplastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vohicles,

Livestock,

Milk, in milk shipping cans or in bottles in cases or crates,

Motor vehicles when towed by a tow car,

Mushrooms, fresh (not cold pack nor frozen),

Newspapers: newspaper supplements, sections or inserts (not scrap nor waste),

841 Nuts, in the shell,

> Nuts, field shelled (rough shelled, with or without removal of broken shells, dirt, residue, or foreign material, and not cleaned nor further processed),

Optical goods transported from or to wholesale houses in packages weighing 10 pounds or less,

Property of the United States, or property transported under an agreement whereby the United States contracted for the carrier's services,

Property transported to a United States Post Office for mailing and United States mail transported from a post office to the addressee thereof,

Property shipped to or from producers of motion pictures or television shows when transported subject to the rates, rules and regulations provided by Decision No. 33226, in Cases Nos. 4246 and 4434, as amended,

Shipments weighing 10 pounds or less when transported by carriers which operate no vehicles exceeding a licensed weight of 4,000 pounds,

Used property, viz.: household goods, office and store fixtures and equipment, as described in and for which rates are provided in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-B, and used property as described therein of state, county or municipal governments, or transported under an agreement whereby the governments contracted for the carrier's services,

Vegetables, fresh or green (not cold pack nor frozon),

Voting Booths, ballot boxes, election tents and election supplies when transported from or to polling places.
