SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. **68359**, issued today, the Commission established Minimum Rate Tariff No. 16, which sets forth minimum rates, rules and regulations for the transportation of houses and other buildings including their contents, within and between defined areas in southern California. The decision states that, when transported subject to the provisions of said Minimum Rate Tariff No. 16, the contents of houses and other buildings will not be subject to the provisions of other of the Commission's minimum rate tariffs. It further states that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, each tariff should be amended by separate order. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32504, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein,

to become effective January 23, 1965, Second Revised Page 13-A, which page is attached hereto and by this reference is made a part hereof.

2. In all other respects said Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
