O R D E R

Department of Public Works of the State of California is hereby authorized to construct State Route 111 (old Route 187) at separated grades over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, to be identified as Palm Springs Overhead (Crossing No. B-580.54-A) near the City of Palm Springs in Riverside County, at the location described and in the manner as shown in the application.

Clearances shall be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D, except that vertical clearances shall be not less than 24'-2" in accordance with plan attached to the application.

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs by further order.

Upon completion of the "Palm Springs Overhead", and its being open to public travel, the existing grade separation commonly

referred to as "West Palm Springs Underpass" (Crossing No. B-580.6-B) shall be physically removed and replaced by compacted fill, and track restored.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
